We support our local communities by hosting four academic golf programs including McKendree University, SWIC,


There were some remarkable accomplishments for Cardinal Creek last season. We were able to execute \$654.4K in the best golf programs in the area and in the Air Force.



here are two "S" words that golfers dread more than any other: The first is the dreaded "shank". The second is the slightly less-dreaded, but far more common "slice".

Our partners at GOLFTEC have spent countless hours diving deep into the causes - and effects - of the most widespread problem in golf. They found that about 60 percent of all golfers hit a slice, with an average score of 101, and higher-handicaps tend to miss to the right of their target more than half the time.

Sound like you? Turns out, there's one cause above all else that's probably causing you to slice so many shots. Your clubface is probably open at impact.

What may seem obvious to some isn't to others: The clubface is king in golf. The direction the clubface is pointing at impact will influence the ball's direction more than anything else in your swing. When it comes to handicap, GOLFTEC found that lower handicaps tend to keep their clubface a lot more square on their downswing - within about a degree of their swing direction - than anybody else. Higher handicaps have their clubface between three and five degrees more open (which means pointing to the right of the target) on the downswing.

When the clubface is open, it means it is pointing to the right of the target, which means that is almost certainly where the ball is going to go. So, why is your face open? There are a few different factors, but one of the most common is your grip. A "weak" grip causes an open clubface, so if you are slicing the ball and trying to figure out why, that is where you should look first.

As GOLF Top 100 Teacher Jason Carbone explains, "a good antislice grip requires gripping the club in your fingers, NOT the palm of your hands."

And once you do that, PGA Tour player Tony Finau - who once struggled with a slice himself - explains here that turning your hands more to the right (for right-handed golfers) will help strengthen your grip, and therfore prevent the clubface from opening too much.

Finau made this grip change himself. Here is a picture of his before (slice) grip, and his after (power fade) grip.

Or of course you can always just book a lesson.

The teacher in him enjoys seeing the learning that goes on outside of the classroom. He says it is rewarding to see players start to manage a course based on his instruction, playing smarter and scoring better.

The now retired head girl's golf coach at Belleville East Rich Maue, chose to coach because he loves golf and found it rewarding when players improved year after year. Many had never picked up a club when they started, but by senior year they would score in the 80's. Rewarding! It is the feeling of making a difference in these young lives that is so satisfying!!

Handling nervous players is an important part of being a coach. One of my favorite memories involves a player that was very nervous as she waited on the first tee. It was a difficult hole with water between the tee and the green. We talked about the shot she was about to hit then our conversation turned to one of her hobbies, yoga. It took her mind off the shot and I saw her relax. Prior to the hole near the tee, you guessed it she took a brief yoga pose. First shot right up the middle!

Earlier this fall, I took the whole team to Kentucky, my first time taking a team to a tournament by myself, I was excited! They had been playing well and had won 2 of their last 3 tournaments. Go Bearcats!!!! The day before we left, Ford recalled our 15-passenger van. Driving a rented minivan with seven women, clubs, luggage, snacks, a case of water, pillows, we filled up the van and off we went. They finished in 4th place against a tough lineup of teams.  $W^{\rm henever\ I}$ think about all the years I have spent playing golf, I can't believe how differently I looked at the game after I joined a weekly league. It fundamentally changed the way I played, how I thought about my game, and how much enjoyment I get out of it. A golf league may not be for everyone, but here are 4 great reasons why you should consider joining. - James McCormick

PLAY BETTER

If you have confidence in your game, and even if you don't, the one thing that you can be sure of is the simple act of playing more will improve your game. This especially goes for the one round a month or less type of golfer. More than that, when you play in competition your focus improves, and you now have goals when you are on the course. You think more strategically about your game and your decision making. Over time you do more of the little things well. In short, you will get better by playing more often in competition.

BUILD FRIENDSHIPS

Camaraderie is one of the biggest reasons I play league golf. The time honored tradition of discussing your round with the golfers you played with and the good natured banter about both successes and failures gets better with more friends and league mates in attendance. Let's face it, the shared experience of a golf game can bring together people who otherwise would not have anything in common. The camaraderie of a good golf league may be the best reason to play in one.

PLAY MORE

I remember my first season of league golf. I committed to getting out 10 times that season, and by the time I had finished the first few months of play I had already been out 8 times. That was 3 more times than I had played the entire year before. Why? In league play there is just more reasons to play every week. First, the competition in league play brings an added level of motivation to get out and play. Recognition from other golfers when you finish atop the leader-board is great, but what really got me out more often was all the new opportunities to play with a much larger group of people. Any time I wanted to play a round of golf, I could, thanks to my golf league.

HAVE MORE FUN

I love the old saying that "a bad day of golf beats a good day at the office." This is never more true than in league play. We are taught as children that competition offers the opportunity to learn and improve at whatever sport we are playing. So even if I'm losing, sometimes badly, I get much more out of the round than with just a casual game. Besides, I relish the likely abuse I'll get afterwards and if you play league golf, you will too.





Chicken Cordon Bleu

Classic chicken cordon bleu is breaded and then fried. We like to skip the frying and bake it. It takes what is otherwise a tedious recipe and simplifies it a bit. Or at least lets you skip the giant pot of oil and the inevitable cleanup. Once the chicken is layered with cheese and ham, then rolled. It's one big piece of chicken, so frying it seemed like too much. The chicken will bake into a beautiful, golden, and crispy piece of meat that is perfectly swirled on the inside.

Chicken cordon bleu sauce really completes this dish. It is creamy and tangy, and like a next-level gravy. You start by making a basic gravy, and then add dijon mustard and cheese to take it into a class all on its own.




Ingredients

- chicken breasts
- slices Swiss Cheese try hot pepper cheese for spicey alternative
- 8 ounces Prosciutto Ham may substitute with any quality ham
- cup all-purpose flour
- 2 large eggs- beaten
- 2 cups Italian Style Breadcrumbs Panko crumbs work well also
- 4 tablespoons melted butter
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- Kosher salt
- fresh ground black pepper

Sauce

- 4 tablespoons butter
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 cups milk
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1/3 cup freshly grated Parmesan again try hot pepper cheese Yield: 4 servings | Prep Time: 10 mins | Total Time: 1 hr 10 mins Calories per serving: 1238
- 1. See step 8 and pour a glass of wine to enjoy while cooking.
- 2. Preheat oven to 400° and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper OR try Air Frying for 12 minutes seam side-down at 400°.
 - Why make Chicken Cordon Bleu in the air fryer?
 For starters, it comes out super crispy and golden brown. It is also much faster than baking it in the oven. It only takes about 12 minutes to cook and doesn't require any time waiting for the oven to preheat, although we recommend you let the air fryer preheat while you prep the chicken.
 Cooking the chicken seam-side down might seem counterintuitive, but trust me. It will hold its shape better, so you won't lose that gooey, cheesy filling. Just be sure to secure everything the best you can with a toothpick or two but don't forget to remove them before serving!
- 3. Place chicken breast between two pieces of plastic wrap on a cutting board and flatten to a ¼ inch thickness with a meat mallet or rolling pin. Top chicken with 2 slices of cheese, then 2 ounces of ham. Starting at the top of the breast, roll up tightly and secure with toothpicks. Repeat with remaining.



breadcrumbs and mix until incorporated.

- 5. Working with one at a time, roll chicken first in flour, then eggs, then in breadcrumbs, pressing to coat. Place on prepared baking sheet. Bake until golden and cooked through, 30 minutes.
- Make sauce: in a large skillet over medium heat, melt butter. Add flour and stir until golden,
 2 minutes. Slowly whisk in milk, then add mustard. Let simmer until thickened, 5 minutes.
 Add freshly grated cheese and stir until melted.
 Season with salt and pepper.
- 7. Allow to rest 5 minutes before serving, remove toothpicks from chicken and serve with sauce.
- 8. Wine pairings: Chicken Cordon Bleu pairs well with both white and red wines, we suggest Sauvignon Blanc or even Prosecco for whites. For red wine lovers, Pinot Noir is one of the best pairings as a dry, crisp red.
- 9. Enjoy!

He asked the bartender to strengthen his cocktail, an Americano, so the bartender replaced the soda water with gin and added an orange peel instead of the Americano's typical lemon peel. Now the experimental drink of gin, vermouth, and Campari has become a

In a rocks glass over ice, combine Campari, gin, and sweet vermouth.Add carbonated water and garnish with lemon wedge.







Healing Your Golf Game with Precision!

■ hen most people go to the doctors office they begin by telling the doc what their symptoms have been and what has been going wrong. The doctor then uses their expertise, knowledge, and experience to make a diagnosis and then provides some kind of solution to make the patient better.

In the golf world, a golf instructor is very much like a doctor for your golf game, except when you go to an instructor for lessons most of the time the symptons are not reported correctly and therefor the diagnosis is completely wrong. Most of you that have gotten a lesson have shown up, the instructor will ask you what you want to work on, and then you get to work fixing that issue.

The reason we all want to be better at golf is to shoot lower scores. If we shoot lower scores every other reason we play the game will be that much more enjoyable. What I'm getting at is, how can I as a golf professional, help you get better at golf when you come to me with an area that you think needs to be improved upon, but that symptom might not be what's causing your scores to be so high?

Last season I started a new program that entails on course learning while we actually play the game of golf. The game is not played on a driving range. A flat, wide open target area with no penalties. Golf is played in an ever changing environment in which your target and your visual picture changes with each and every shot. No two shots are the same on the

course but that's all we practice on the range. I stand up there and watch all you range rats beating golf balls for hours and I always wonder, are they getting better at golf? They are getting better at hitting balls but what about playing the game? You should ask yourselves that as well.

New this season I'm going to be doing 9 hole playing assessments where I take 4 players out on the golf course and track your statistics in a way that will give us a very precise picture as to what is causing your high scores. That same person that came to me wanting to fix their slice might miss 4 putts inside of three feet while we play and at the same time hit every fairway down the right side. In golf it's always best to address the low hanging fruit first, in this case it would be putts inside of 5 feet. A very easy aspect of the game to fix.

We come up with a routine, maybe use the line on the ball to line up the putt, and possibly work on a stroke mechanic. 30 minutes of work and you've saved 4 shots over 9 holes.

The playing assessment is my way of being the Doctor for your golf game. If you truly want to get the most of your talent, time, and effort, you need to know exactly what to fix and develop a plan that will get you to your goals. I can help you get there.

Last season I introduced on course group playing lessons. For those of you that signed up you got to experience the most efficient and effective way to learn the game of golf. Each one of my clients that signed up for the group on course lessons ended up shooting the lowest round of their lives at some point last season. One of my players even lowered their handicap by 18 strokes. I was skeptical at the start of last season but throughout the summer it was evident that this is a far superior method of learning rather than banging golf balls on the driving range. The range has its purpose and is certainly useful, but if you want to get better at playing the game, the golf course is the best option.




