## Fishing Rules

- Current base fishing permit is required- we do not require an IL fishing license.
- Fishing is allowed from shore, docks, and non-motorized craft.



**No Motors Allowed on the lake!**



- Bait can ONLY be synthetic, worms or crickets
- Ice Fishing is not allowed.
- Fishing poles and hand lines only! Seine, spears, bows or trout lines not allowed

## Scott Lake Recreation Area Rules

- No swimming, or wading in the lakes. Do not walk on any solid ice!
- No discharge of any type of firearm or bow allowed within the Scott Lake Recreation area.
- If on the lake, Coast Guard approved life jackets required.
- Do not approach or feed wildlife.
- Picnic areas beside the front lake are available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Please remove any trash or debris once you are ready to leave.
- Parking is available at the bathhouse.

## Snake on Scott AFB

If you see a snake in the recreation area, please keep your distance. Illinois has many different species of native snake that are both venomous and non-venomous.

If a snake appears non-aggressive please leave it alone and keep children and pets away.

If the snake is in a populated area and is aggressive or identified as venomous please contact CE 618-256-2202 for removal. Monitor the location of the snake from a safe distance until CE arrives.

## Archery Range Rules

Archery range is located East of ODR on East Dr near the Combat Arms Training Classroom.

- Permitted bows include long, recurve or compound bows. No crossbows allowed.
- Broadheads not allowed on range targets.
- No discharge of firearms, air or CO2 powered guns or bows allowed.
- All archers must fire from the same line, no crossing shots, roving or clout.
- No firing allowed when others are down range.
- When collecting arrows down range, always leave your bow at the shooting line.
- Archers under 18 must be supervised by an adult.
- No alcoholic beverages.
- Personal equipment must be inspected by the individual and maintained for safe operation.
- No fighting or horseplay allowed.
- Please pick up any trash or debris.

Any violations of these rules could result in range closure.
